All board approved funds are then wired to the MGRC Tanzania bank account in Arusha, Tanzania. The sole authorized signer on the MGRC Tanzania account is Richard J. Morro, Founder. Neither MGRC USA, nor a ny of the other USA Board members have any access to or authority over, such foreig n account. There were many expenses related to our mission. MGRC International has a total of 62 rescued girls who are fully supported by MGRC USA. This support in cludes all health & medical expenses, clothing, nutritious meals, schooling and tut oring. This support also includes development of the MGRC International fully sust ainable ecoFarm and ecoVillage.

MGRC USA Began construction of 3 ecoHomes in FY2022. Each home is large enough to house 20 girls and 6 house mothers. Construction was begun after receiving 100% of total necessary funds including prior FY21 retained earnings.
